

Where is Abu Dhabi's solar power plant located?

Located in Al Ajban, 70 km northeast of Abu Dhabi, the large-scale plant is expected to power 160,000 households across the UAE, reducing the emirate's carbon emissions by 2.4 million metric tonnes per year. Solar energy deployment is expanding rapidly in Abu Dhabi.

Is Abu Dhabi a leading region for solar power adoption?

Abu Dhabi is among the leading regions of the world for solar power adoption as shown by the Al Dhafra and Noor projects.

How many solar panels are installed per day in Abu Dhabi?

During development, a record-breaking 10 MW of solar panels were installed on average per day. Shams is a 100-megawatt (MW) concentrated solar power (CSP) plant located in the Western Region of Abu Dhabi. The plant is approximately 120 km southwest of Abu Dhabi.

How will EWEC boost Abu Dhabi's solar power generation capacity?

It will increase EWEC's total solar PV capacity to about 5.5 GW. EWEC's aim is to boost Abu Dhabi's solar power generation capacity to 13 GW by 2030 and supply 60% of Abu Dhabi's total power demand from renewable and clean energy sources by 2035.

Ewec refers to its first three utility-scale solar PV projects as PV1-3. PV1, or Noor Abu Dhabi, has a capacity of 935MW and has been operational since 2019. PV2, the 1,584MW Al Dhafra solar IPP, was inaugurated in November last year.

The 2GW PV project will be the biggest solar power facility in the UAE by surpassing the 1.2GW Noor Abu Dhabi solar power project that commenced operations in April 2019. EWEC received 48 expressions of interest in July 2019 as part of a tendering process initiated for the Al Dhafra solar project in February 2019.
