

What is US - North Macedonia trade?

U.S. - North Macedonia trade through Q3 of 2021 totaled \$247 million, of which U.S. exports to North Macedonia were \$65 million. Member of European Free Trade Agreement (EFTA) and Central European Free Trade Agreement (CEFTA); bilateral Free Trade Agreements with Turkey and Ukraine.

Does North Macedonia have a trade deficit?

North Macedonia's trade structure has been traditionally in deficit, however, the gap between imports and exports had been gradually decreasing in recent years. In 2021, the country exported goods worth USD 8.1 billion - a 23.3% increase compared to the previous year - importing USD 11.3 billion (+30% y-o-y).

What are the exports of North Macedonia?

During the last five reported years the exports of North Macedonia have changed by \$4.98B from \$4.54B in 2017 to \$9.52B in 2022. The most recent exports are led by Reaction and Catalytic Products (\$2.64B), Insulated Wire (\$644M), Electricity (\$553M), Motor vehicles; parts and accessories (8701 to 8705) (\$274M), and Seats (\$268M).

What is the value of exports from North Macedonia in 2022?

According to preliminary data from the State Statistical Office, the total value of exported goods from the Republic of North Macedonia in the period January-December 2022 amounted to USD 8.7 billion, a 6.6% increase compared to the same period one year earlier; whereas the value of imported goods stood at USD 12.7 billion, 12% more year-on-year.

Does North Macedonia rely on international markets?

That 19.1% for exports to overall GDP in PPP for 2023 compares to 21% one year earlier. Those percentages indicate a decreasing reliance on products sold on international markets for North Macedonia's total economic performance, albeit based on a short timeframe.

Is North Macedonia a member of the EU?

Overall, the EU accounted for 78.3% of total exports and 46.8% of imports. North Macedonia became a member of the WTO (World Trade Organisation) in April 2003. Following a cooperation agreement with the EU, North Macedonia signed a Stabilisation and Association Agreement, which concedes the country duty-free access to European markets.

While an attractive market for many investors, companies may experience market challenges in North Macedonia. The slow-moving judicial system, some legislative and regulatory contradictions, a relatively slow bureaucracy, and weak rule of law and corruption can cause issues as companies enter and operate in the market.

North Macedonia's lack of transparency, political favoritism, corruption, and mismanagement are historically serious obstacles for companies bidding on public tenders. ... North Macedonia-U.S. trade in agricultural products slightly dropped from USD 40.5 million in 2017 to USD 39.5 million in 2018. The U.S. share of North Macedonia's agricultural imports increased 0.05 percent in 2018 to 1.06 percent of total imports, while the share of North Macedonia's agricultural exports going to the United States dropped ...

Companies should research North Macedonia's market before implementing promotional activities, as strategies used in the United States may not be equally effective in North Macedonia. Price is usually the decisive selling factor since disposable income in North Macedonia remains low compared to Western European countries.
