Bhutan's first elected government announced a plan to export 10,000 MW of power by 2020, and India agreed to buy this amount in 2012. One imminent project is the construction of Bhutan's first mega solar power plant, a 17MW plant in Sephu, Wangdue. Today, all of Bhutan's electricity generation is from renewables such as hydropower, wind, and solar. However, 78 percent of the country's energy consumption is supplied by fossil fuels, largely for transportation purposes.
