

A 7kW solar system is medium-to-large sized and covers close to 100% of the average home's energy use. But how much does it cost and how much can you save? ... With 1,000 watts equal to 1 kW, a 7kW installation would need 27 "standard" panels (7000 watts divided by 265 watts = 26.4, rounded up to 27 panels).

Subsidy won under the program can be used to install PV systems of 1 kW (3 solar panels) or 2 kW (6 solar panels) capacity. A 1 kW system can bring the beneficiary family to expect annual savings of \$150,000, while a 2 kW system can double it to \$300,000 annually. It does not include batteries.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt. This comes out to \$24,930 for a 9-kilowatt system before federal tax incentives, so the net cost of a 9-kW solar energy system would be \$18,448. This cost doesn't factor in any state or utility rebates and incentives for going solar.

The total footprint of a 3.2kW solar system can be calculated by multiplying the number of panels (11) by the individual panel size (17 sqft).
