Where are the Cocos Islands located?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands are an archipelago in the Indian Ocean about 1000 km west of Indonesia. The dwarf state has a total area of only 14 km<sup>2</sup>; (five mi<sup>2</sup>;) and a total coastline of 26 km (16.2 mi). This land area is about 4.2 times the size of NY Central Park.

How many islands are in the Cocos Islands?

The archipelago consists of 27 islands. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have no direct neighbors. The distance between New York City and the Capital West Island is about 16,730 km (10,396 mi). The countrywide time on the Cocos Islands is Cocos Islands Time (CCT), which is currently 13.5 hours ahead of Los\_Angeles.
