Dolphin currently operates the only 48 inch diameter export pipeline in the Middle East, so looking for local comparisons is out of the question.

How many storage tanks does Dolphin Energy have?

Dolphin Energy constructed six storage tanks for condensate at Ras Laffan. The combined storage capacity totals 3.32 million barrels. Dolphin Energy's propane and butane production is held in shared storage tanks which are jointly used by several LPG producing entities.
