

Wallis and Futuna is known for its customary festivals deeply rooted in its culture, giving rhythm to the daily life of its inhabitants. These ceremonies are called Katoaga and take place during a religious holiday (the different districts celebrate their patron saint each year), a family event or secular holidays such as July 14 or the ...

In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-Calédonie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory. Two years earlier Banque Indosuez had closed its branch at Mata-Utu, leaving the territory without any bank. Following this, the Bank of Wallis-and-Futuna (BWF) with its head office in Wallis was created in 1991.

Wallis and Futuna comprises two archipelagoes: Hoorn Islands group (also known as the Futuna Islands, and as &#206;les Horne). Futuna Island (pop.~5,000); Alofi Island (uninhabited) Alofi Island is the smaller of the two. According to legend it was as densely inhabited as Futuna up until the 19th century, when the Futuna people slaughtered and ate the population in a single raid.

Wallis and Futuna is a French overseas and located in the South Pacific two-thirds of the way between Hawaii and New Zealand. The capital is Mata-Utu and the population is 16,000. Education. As an overseas collectivity of France, Wallis and Futuna follows the French educational system and curricula.

The remote French territory of Wallis and Futuna lies in a not-so-remote corner of the Pacific Ocean, with tourist hubs such as Fiji just 786 km (488 mi) to the southwest. Despite being an off-the-radar destination, the French territory of Wallis and Futuna offers an authentic Pacific Island travel experience, well away from the tourist hordes.
