Guatemala City (Spanish: Ciudad de Guatemala), (also known nationally colloquially by the nickname as Guate), is the national capital and largest city of the Republic of Guatemala. [4 ]It is also a municipality capital of the Guatemala Department and the most populous urban metropolitan area in the region of Central America.

The name "Guatemala" comes from the Nahuatl word Cuauhtēmall, or "place of many trees", a derivative of the K'iche' Mayan word for "many trees" [15 ][16 ] or, perhaps more specifically, for the Cuate/Cuatli tree *Eysenhardtia*.

What is Guatemala known for?

Guatemala City also dominates the cultural life of the country. It is the seat of the principal faculties of the San Carlos University of Guatemala (established 1676 in Antigua Guatemala); the major institutions for artistic, commercial, vocational, and military education; the Society of Geography and History; and several important museums.
