

Where are the Heard and McDonald Islands located?

The Heard and McDonald Islands are a Commonwealth of Australia foreign territory located roughly halfway between Australia and the land of South Africa. The remote islands are located in the southern Indian Ocean, 2,547.6 mi (4,100 km) of Perth, and roughly 1,242.7 mi (2,000 km) north of Australia's station at Davis Station in Antarctica.

How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km² (144 sq mi) and it has 101.9 km (63 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century, the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

Are Heard Island and McDonald Islands protected?

Heard Island and the McDonald Islands are highly protected due to their World Heritage property status and location within an IUCN 1a Strict Nature Reserve. It is a tough location to reach, and anyone interested in visiting the islands must first acquire permission from the Australian Antarctic Division.

Is Heard Island a volcano?

Heard Island makes up almost all the landmass of the territory and it's mostly covered in glaciers. The island is dominated by the massive Maswon Peak, a 9,000-foot active volcano. Maswon is also the highest peak of Australia, surpassing the 7,300-foot Mount Kosciuszko in New South Wales, the tallest mountain on the Australian mainland.

Who inhabited Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

American sealers inhabited the Heard Island and McDonald Islands in the late 1800s. In 1910, the United Kingdom officially acquired Heard Island and the McDonald Islands, which is later handed to Australia. In 1947, the islands were claimed by Australia.

Why are the Heard and McDonald Islands important?

The Heard and McDonald Islands are interesting from a historical perspective because they are one of the few places in the world where two claim lines intersect. There is an ongoing dispute between Argentina and Chile over who has sovereignty over these islands.

Early scientific visits. The first recorded scientific visit to Heard Island was by the Challenger in 1874, when a brief landing was made at Atlas Cove and a few scientific samples were collected. Poor weather limited the visit to 3 hours. Later the same year, the Arcona brought a German expedition to Heard Island, looking for suitable sites for observing a transit of Venus.
