British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT),overseas territory of the United Kingdom in the central Indian Ocean,established in 1965. Since 1976 it has been coterminous with the Chagos Archipelago. Lying at the centre of the Indian Ocean region and out of the path of cyclonic storms,the territory is strategically located.

How many islands are in the British Indian Ocean territory?

Map of the British Indian Ocean Territory since 1976. The territory is an archipelago of 58 islandscovering 56 square kilometres (22 sq mi). The largest island is Diego Garcia,which at 32.5 square kilometres (12.5 sq mi) accounts for about half of the territory's total land area.

Why was the British Indian Ocean Territory created?

During the Cold War an agreement between the governments of Britain and the United States led to the creation in 1965 of the British Indian Ocean Territory for the purpose of establishing defense and communications facilities to counterbalance the Soviet military presence in the region.

Can You Moor a boat in the Indian Ocean?

Yacht crews seeking safe passage across the Indian Ocean may apply for a mooring permitfor the uninhabited Outer Islands (beyond Diego Garcia),but must not approach within 3 nautical miles (5.6 kilometres; 3.5 miles),land on,or anchor at islands designated as Strict Nature Reserves,or the nature reserve within the Peros Banhos atoll.

British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) lies about 1770 km east of Mahe (the main island of the Seychelles). The territory, an archipelago of 55 islands, covers some 54,400 sq km of ocean. The islands have a land area of only 60 sq km and 698 km of coastline. Diego Garcia, the largest and most southerly island, is 44 sq km.
