

What does the Department of energy do in Lesotho?

The Department of Energy is committed to increasing energy access and ensuring security of energy supply in the country. How much electricity does Lesotho produce?

Lesotho produces about 72 MW from hydropower (Meula). It has about 150 MW peak power and imports more than 70 MW mainly from Mozambique (29% of peak demand) and 20% of its peak demand from South Africa. The electricity supply accounts only for +-50% in the energy mix.

Can Lesotho produce 450 MW of hydropower?

According to Lesotho's Department of Energy, Lesotho could potentially produce 450 MW in hydropower and several hundred more with wind power. However, only 17 percent of this potential is being exploited, 96 percent of it at the 'Muela hydro-power plant and the rest from mini hydro-power plants at Mants'onyane, Mokhotlong, Tsoelike, and Semonkong.

Can Lesotho export wind power?

Breeze Power, a company owned jointly by GOKL and Harrison & White Investments, is investigating twelve sites for wind power generation. Energy demand is growing in South Africa and the rest of the region, and Lesotho has the potential to export renewable power.

Who supplies electricity to Lesotho?

All power to Lesotho was supplied by Eskom in South Africa in 1995. However, the Muela hydroelectric power station, built during phase 1A of the Lesotho Highlands Water Project (LHWP), opened in September 1998. The resulting election reduced Lesotho's previous dependence on imported electricity
