As per the tender announcement, Adwea will only pay for the net electrical energy supplied by the plant. Solar Insight manager Jenny Chase was quoted by The National as saying at Bloomberg New Energy Finance: "Adwea did dip a toe in the solar market by co-investing with Masdar in a 2.3MW PV portfolio in Abu Dhabi in 2011.

Located 35 kilometres from Abu Dhabi city, the project was co-developed with Abu Dhabi National Energy Company, French power company EDF Renewables and Chinese solar developer JinkoPower.
