The solar farm is part of a broader project for the expansion of the Mt Coffe hydropower plant to 126 MW. The two initiatives are estimated at USD 96 million. In addition, Liberia plans to build a new hydropower plant, St Paul 2 (SP2), upstream of the St Paul River which is expected to produce between 150 MW and 200 MW. (USD 1 = EUR 0.918)
