São Tomé and Príncipe is one of the least visited countries in the world, making a Sao Tome Itinerary a rarity to come by. With a population of 230,000, only around 33,000 people visit each year. Off the coast of Gabon, this Portuguese-speaking island state is literally ripe with cacao, vanilla, and plantains, and brimming with fresh fish everywhere you go.

Furthermore, investing in solar technologies could take inspiration from Greece, where solar accounts for almost a quarter of their electricity generation. Such transitions are crucial to align São Tomé and Príncipe with global trends towards low-carbon futures, benefitting from reduced emissions and enhanced energy security.

Language: Portuguese is the official language of Sao Tome and Principe. English is not widely spoken or understood. Currency: Credit cards are not widely accepted in Sao Tome and Principe. ATMs in Sao Tome and Principe mostly accept cards from local banks. Travelers must exchange their currency for the Sao Tomean Dobra.
