

Is Timor-Leste a good country for solar energy?

Timor-Leste has a high-quality solar resource. The global horizontal irradiance in Dili is higher than on the east coast of Australia, where the solar market is mature and installation costs are higher. The cost of electricity in Timor-Leste for commercial and industrial consumers is high compared to ASEAN countries.

Is there a market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste?

Australia's Market Development Facility (MDF) and ITP Renewables conducted an assessment of the potential market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste.

Could solar power be a viable solution in Timor-Leste?

In parts of Timor-Leste with low population densities, solar home systems are likely to be the only feasible solution for electrifying small hamlets of 5-30 households at least a few kms from the existing grid, as well as very small villages remote from the power grid.

Can Timor-Leste be used as a power source?

Indications are that there are insufficient biomass reserves in Timor-Leste to allow commercial utilization as energy sources. Coal- /oil-fired steam power generation, offshore gas and nuclear power are all large-scale options, and are not considered feasible for Timor-Leste, which has a relatively small power system. III.

What are the main sources of energy in Timor-Leste?

Fossil fuels in Timor-Leste are imported from neighbouring countries such as Indonesia and Australia. Seventy-five percent of oil imports are used for electricity production, with the remaining 25 percent consumed in the transport sector. Other sources of energy. Lighting needs are met by the use of kerosene, plant oils and batteries.

Is wind power economic in West Timor-Leste?

A USAID-funded wind project has been on going in the "NTT Province" of Indonesia that also includes West Timor. Based on West Timor data, this study concludes that wind power is probably not economic in coastal areas, but it may prove to be economic in the uplands and mountains of Timor-Leste both for grid connected and off-grid applications.
