Once online, the solar-plus-storage system will operate under a 20-year power purchase agreement (PPA) with the state-owned St. Kitts Electric Company (SKELEC), charging a flat rate for the entire period.

St Kitts and Nevis taxes for individuals. There are no income and inheritance taxes in St Kitts and Nevis for individuals, whether they are tax or non-tax residents of the country. Withholding taxes are paid by non-tax residents of St Kitts and Nevis. The tax rate is fixed -- 15% of the payments. Tax residents don't pay withholding taxes.
