

How much will TotalEnergies invest in Iraq?

TotalEnergies and its partners, Basrah Oil Company and QatarEnergy, will invest \$10 billion in the Gas Growth Integrated Project in Iraq, which includes the development of a 1 GW solar power plant.

What is Iraq's solar project?

The project aims to improve Iraq's electricity supply and increase regional oil production while also recovering flared gas and building a seawater treatment plant. The Saudi company ACWA Power has been invited to join the solar project.

Does Iraq have solar power?

And UAE-based developer Masdar signed an agreement with Iraq's government in June to build a 2 GW solar project. According to the International Renewable Energy Agency, Iraq has just 216 MW of installed PV capacity, despite having huge solar potential. No additional solar power has been deployed in the country over the last three years.

Will TotalEnergies build a 1 GW solar plant in Iraq?

TotalEnergies plans to build a 1 GW solar plant near the port of Basra, in southern Iraq. The Iraqi government has revealed that France's TotalEnergies will build a 1 GW solar park in Artawi, near the southern port of Basra, Iraq. The two sides signed a \$27 billion framework agreement on Sunday.

Will ACWA Power join a solar project in Iraq?

TotalEnergies will invite ACWA Power, a Saudi company, to join the solar project in agreement with Iraqi authorities. The project is expected to attract foreign investment and support the country's transition to renewable energy.
