Who regulates the energy sector in Trinidad & Tobago?

The MEEI (Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries) manages Trinidad and Tobago's oil, gas, and mineral resources. The MEEI is responsible for monitoring, controlling, and regulating the country's energy and mineral sectors. The Regulated Industries Commission also serves as a regulator for the energy sector.

What is the future of solar energy in Trinidad & Tobago?

In 2020, BP, Shell, and Lightsource won a bid to provide grid scale renewable energy throughout Trinidad and Tobago. In 2021, the Trinidad and Tobago Solar Energy Market was projected to grow from 3 MW of solar power in 2020 to approximately 184 MW by 2026.
